UPDATE PRIZE MONEY HAS CHANGED:

Race Relay has been finalized as far as how it will go also, please read below.....

Event schedule has changed some also. Again make sure you read the full layout.

Categories

Hangtime:

- jump and hang as long as possible
- one jump at a time, 3 times circle
- rider limitation 20 (men 15, women 5) men and women separate

-2 judges with timing watch, the average of 3 jumps will be taken, will be announced immediately after jump, moderator to be standing next to judges.

Best Hooked:

- show us your best trick being hooked in
- technical grade and height
- rider limitation 20 (men 15, women 5) men and women separate
- 2 judges, height 50%, technical 50%

Best Unhooked:

- show us your best trick unhooked
- technical grade and height
- rider limitation 20 (men 15, women 5) men and women separate
- 2 judges, height 50%, technical 50%

Kiteloop:

- highest
- most radical
- one jump at a time, 3 times circle
- rider limitation 20 (men 15, women 5) men and women separate
- 2 judges, 50% height, 50% technical

Most Spins:

- as many spins as you can crank out
- when same amount of spins, the technical grade and height will be judged
- one jump at a time, 2 times circle
- rider limitation 20 (men 15, women 5) men and women separate
- 2 judges, most spins wins, if riders have same amount of spins, then he/she who had the most altitude wins.

Race Relay:

- team of 4 riders
- short race course with beach start, all teams will draw for position for beach start at the skippers meeting and each team will be assigned a number at that time. Start will be with kite down ready to launch. At sound of horn, team mates will launch there No.1 person, the No.1 person will then run to the water and go downwind to the small lagoon, enter the lagoon and go around flag post, exit lagoon and run across sandbar then kite upwind back to their start position. Their team member must land them, then that rider must launch his team member. This process will be repeated until all four team members have completed the course. First team to finish (with kite being landed) wins the race, 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- team limitation 20 (80 riders) men and women together.
- This is one round only. All teams will draw for position on the beach start grid. Best team wins.....We will cover the full details of the race and answer

questions at the skippers meetings. The above narrative is to give a general idea of how it will play out.

Racing Rules:

-general racing rules apply. Right of way needs to be respected (right hand in front has right of way) downwind kite needs to be lowered, upwind kite needs to be raised. General safety rules.

-judges: 2 judges, they will decide who looks best and gets the highest.

-awarding: after all riders have completed their jumps, judges will announce the winner.
